As we come to the end of 2020, we look over this year as one of our ministry's busiest years. Despite Covid-19 stopping us from traveling, BulldozerFaith reached beyond the lockdown boundaries, ministering into the homes of thousands around the world.

We launched our Daily Devotional platform and added our podcast programming, which we are blessed to use to bring the hope of Yeshua to so many.

Next year, we will also be launching Crossing Point Fellowship, a global community that will identify and support followers into leadership. We seek to invest our time ministering to the unsaved in the communities of those who desire to become active in spreading the message of Yeshua to the hungry.

Ministry life in Israel is a privilege and a blessing, but it has not been an easy journey due to the many assignments the enemy has used to silence our voice, constantly attacking our stand in the Land. Nevertheless, we have been faithful on the battlefield and can testify to the breakthroughs the Father continues to bring us through.

We know our Elohim is faithful, and we trust in His protection and strength on the battlefield. Moreover, BulldozerFaith's patrons and prayer partners' support has been heard, received and felt as we continue to fight the war ahead of us.

In 2013, my family and I were in a life-changing car accident; we rolled the car three times, and I was ejected through the windshield. I broke my skull, eight vertebrae, and I now have three herniated disks as well as one ruptured disk. In my recovery, I also gained a lot of weight.

I was airlifted to the nearest trauma center, and during the helicopter flight, the Father said, "Tell him about Me." I knew He meant the flight nurse, so I promised Him I would tell the flight nurse, but what about me???

The Lord said firmly, "It's not about you!" I thought He would say my name, but He allowed all the names of the lost to filter through me. I was very emotional as I felt the names as He feels them, like losing someone dear to you.

Through my three years of recovery, my wife and I leaned heavily on God's Word. We studied for three to four hours a day; the Bible became our entertainment. In 2017 I watched Kenny Russell from Bulldozerfaith speak at church; he was talking about "Stepping over the line," "walking in the Spirit," and having "joy living in kingdom living!" We adopted this Kingdom Living.

My wife and I lost our hobby farm, we lost our car in the wreck, we lost two other cars hitting deer, and our credit score dropped; yet, through all of this, my wife's co-workers asked how we could be joyful?

I said, "My joy comes from the Lord, not the temporary comforts of this world."

Then we bought a camper and started to pray for direction to where God wanted us to go for ministry. We helped in Kansas City, Mo, with the homeless, we ministered in South Dakota to the Native Americans and served food to the poor in St Louis, Mo. We fell in love with serving. We prayed on where God wanted us next, and we hinted to God about wanting to see Montana or Maine. He chose Iowa. I didn't want to go to Iowa, but eventually, we made our way to Iowa, and I felt so ashamed for not wanting to go. We met so many friends and missionaries; we even had one baptism, yahoo!! And we were protected from wildfires, the virus, etc.

While in Iowa, we started listening to Kenny Russell's Daily Devotions on social media, and both my wife and I were hooked. We actually felt the Spirit talk through Kenny's devotionals and through Bulldozerfaith.

We came back to Missouri to wait for the next assignment, and that was when our eighteen-year-old down syndrome daughter came down with leukemia, so we had to sell our camper so we could live within one hour of a hospital. We have since been given an opportunity to purchase a \$600 home, and our friends are coming together to help us remodel it.

We are very excited about this next opportunity to serve our Lord in our ministry, and Kenny is in contact with me to help develop our ministry. My wife and I have zoom meetings with brothers and sisters who want to learn the truth through the Word and live Kingdom Living through the Spirit.

Thank you, Bulldozerfaith and Kenny Russell, for being a mentor and teacher of the Word to me.

The 40-day devotion that Kenny is currently broadcasting was particularly encouraging during this somewhat 'awkward transition' we found our family in...just ask any Irish Catholic about how we like to celebrate Christmas!

We have come to understand that man's traditions appear to be a real element of distraction to what we are slowly and somewhat painfully coming to realize as 'the truth' if we take Scripture seriously.

Getting rid of our 'man-made' holidays in an effort to step away from the 'traditions of men' and seek a way that is in alignment with Scripture has been a welcome burden that we will carry forth as a family.

It was very warming and encouraging to listen to Kenny share his experiences, and one particular evening during Kenny's devotion, he talked about the joy and celebration of Hannukah, which stuck in our minds and helped reinforce our commitment and cemented our decision.

So, equipped with a menorah in one hand and the book of Maccabees in the other, we took the 'Hannukah plunge'.... we chose to share Scripture, simple gifts each night, and arranged more meaningful, simple lights and decorations while praying and seeking the true presence of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

This new experience with the Word being the central focus of our family devotion just felt like the 'right thing to do.' It was encouraging as a family to share nightly Scripture and read the accounts of Judah Maccabee — how did we not know about this Mighty man growing up, or was I just zoned out?

We were not seeking a 'substitute Christmas' but truly felt we were brought closer to the Father by walking in alignment and committing to this big step.

We understand we are not obligated to celebrate what might be labelled as 'Jewish Holidays,' but to move away from the materialism and general stress, gluttony, and overwhelming 'fleshiness' associated with Christmas. We feel this was a truly bold and courageous step that we pray will bring us blessings.

The fear of becoming alienated by family, friends, and community is the narrow path we have chosen as a commitment to what we see as greater obedience. We will strive to continue to diligently seek His Word and the true feast days that are currently strange and unfamiliar.

We are new and uncertain of the new Biblical vocabulary we are encountering — Yeshua HaMashiach, Ruach Ha'Qodesh, Jehovah/Yahuah — and we are not sure how we fit this into the tongue of everyday conversation.

Reading the Bible as a family (almost) every night for the month of December has been incredible and is forming part of a bigger testimony for us as a family. The maturity of our boys to embrace it with the full armour of God has been inspirational and strengthening as parents to witness.

BulldozerFaith has certainly left my family and I blessed and encouraged. We pray that the Father continues to fill us with His Holy Spirit as we accept Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior.

I've been listening to BulldozerFaith's teachings with Kenny Russell since 2009-2010 on YouTube & Facebook.


In June of 2009, Yehovah gave me a dream of how He would strip me of "Christianity." Since then, I've not stepped into a church setting again.
